Plastics Policy

Plastics Policy

At Gleeds, we are committed to sustainability and responsible business practices. Recognising the significant impact that plastic waste has on our planet, we are adopting sustainable business practices with a focus on reducing, reusing and recycling plastic waste across our global operations. This is in line with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDG): SDG12 Responsible production and consumption, SDGs 14 and 15 (Life below water and Life on land) and SDG 13 (Climate action). This policy covers Gleeds as a global entity.

Aim

We aim to reduce plastic waste and seek to eliminate single use plastics from our offices. Where this is not possible, we will handle them in a responsible way.

Reduce

- Prioritise the use of alternative, eco-friendly materials over plastics when feasible.
- Request that suppliers and contractors to provide plastic-free or reduced-plastic packaging options.
- Eliminate the use of single-use plastic items such as cups, water bottles, straws, and cutlery in our offices.
- Implement a reusable and sustainable alternative for disposable plastic items by providing our employees with stainless steel water bottles and cutlery. Disposable drinking cups are made from recycled and/or compostable materials.
- Work with catering suppliers who can provide food and drink items with zero plastic packaging.

Reuse

- Reuse any items that we can, with a focus on electrical equipment.
- Where possible, reuse IT equipment.

Recycle

- Recycle all possible items.
- Have clearly marked recycling bins in all offices.
- Introduce measures to monitor and report the amount of waste that is sent to landfill vs recycled.

Employee Engagement

- Provide training to employees and subcontractors on plastic management practices and the importance of reducing, reusing, and recycling plastic materials.
- Deliver an awareness campaign designed to encourage employees to reduce plastic waste in our operations and source alternatives to single use plastic items.
- Increase the use of recycling facilities across our offices.

Monitoring and evaluation

- We will monitor and report on our plastic waste recycled and taken to landfill, aiming to improve our data collection.
- We will evaluate the impact of working with dedicated recycling partners and seek to roll out initiatives across all Gleeds offices.
- We will conduct a staff survey on usage and recycling rates of plastic within our organisation, seeking alternatives wherever possible.
- We will review this policy annually.
